

A: I advise everyone to obey and respect her. Spiritual authority is not based on age. God has anointed her to lead, and we should support her.


Q: What's your message of encouragement and appreciation to the General Overseer?


What message do you have for the members and the general public on this milestone anniversary?



Meet Pastor James Ufondu, a man of unwavering dedication and unshakeable faith. As the senior pastor of Eternal Hope Christian Mission and founder of Ministers Alive International Fellowship, he has spent his life serving God and spreading the truth of His word. Called by God at the tender age

Pastor James Ufondu, can you tell us your background in ministry?

There, I saw a man preaching to people, and they called him John the Baptist. A voice told me that I would preach like John the Baptist. At that time, I didn't know much about preaching. I woke up, and it felt like it was just a dream. Being a poor boy from a Catholic background, I didn't want to share the dream with anyone. Instead, I decided to move forward with becoming a Roman Catholic priest, so I started serving under a reverend.

That must have been a powerful experience.

How did your journey unfold from there?

As I served under the reverend, I began to feel a strong conviction to preach the word of God. Despite my initial plans to become a Catholic priest, I felt an insatiable hunger to share the Gospel with others. This led me to start preaching, and soon, I was ministering to my

peers and even some adults. My passion for the word of God grew stronger with each passing day, and I knew that I had to dedicate my life to spreading His truth.

What drove you to establish Eternal Hope Christian Mission and Ministers Alive International Fellowship?

My desire to see people transformed by the power of God's word drove me to establish Eternal Hope Christian Mission. I wanted to create a platform where

people could experience the love and hope of Christ. As for Ministers Alive International Fellowship, I felt a strong urge to equip and empower other ministers of the Gospel to effectively share the truth with their communities. I believe that by working together, we can make a greater impact and bring more people to Christ.

Most importantly, always remember that ministry is not about personal gain but about serving others and bringing glory to God.

What is your vision for the future of Eternal Hope Christian Mission and Ministers Alive International Fellowship? My vision is to see these organizations continue to grow and impact lives globally. I envision a network of ministers and believers who are united in their pursuit of spreading the truth and sharing the love of Christ. I pray that we will see a revival of the pure and undiluted word of God, and that many will be transformed by His power.

I'm called to raise men, women who will create wealth




B is hop Solomon Faleti, who is known as Bishop of Wisdom, attended the New Dimensions Seminaries workshop, speaks on the importance and other issue.

The primary target is anyone interested in writing to create wealth while educating and entertaining the people.


From your earlier response, don't you think the program should be inculcate in training for pastors,

if yes what's your plan to extend the training?

We plan to collaborate with local governments and some other government entities to offer the training to youth as well as adults, so that they can have skills that can do more than providing a living for them.

Can you mention some of your school products and their exploits in God's kingdom?

I will not like to mention names of our ex-students as you are requesting because some might mistake it for name dropping. I am satisfied that you who is interviewing graduated from our school in 2018. Our school has been in existence since February 13, 1996 and we have graduated over 15,000 pastors and other clergy men.



We learnt you have college of Bishops and what inspired you establishing the college?

Yes, we have a College of Bishops and Apostles but being Bishops and Apostles is not the primary reason for its existence. The primary purpose of the college is for the great commission.

However the major objective is to remove every barrier that can hinder you from doing the work of God and that includes ordination, elevation and consecration. Instead of allowing those things to hinder a man of God in any way, after due verification, we offer the services.

How do you rate Christianity in Nigeria compare to other countries you have visited?

Christianity in Nigeria can do better than what we are doing presently, particularly in the area of social responsibility which in turn can move the people into the church. There is no basis for comparison between Christianity in Nigeria and other nations. This is particularly the case when ours is compared to the First World because Christianity is relatively young in Nigeria.

As economy is not favourable across the globe, tithe and offering are flowing as usual. What is your advice to men of God?

Even with the economy being buoyant and

Within his short period in Denton Police Station, God has used him to do great exploits and still doing more.

In a chat with the The Unique Model, magazine, he revealed how he was inspired, how he is sourcing funds and people that helped him. Also, he encouraged other State Coordinators to talk to people for support in God's project, assuring that God would touch them to support the growth of his kingdom.

Excerpts:


What inspired you to build a chapel in Denton Police Station within a short period you were posted?

By God's grace I came into the station divinely, God used DIG Sylvester Alabi to bring me here. When I was about coming in as the DPO to Denton, I heard a lot of discouraging reports. Some people said I would be killed, that miscreants would attack me, and that it is not a peaceful community. But I looked upon God to help me serve him and do my official work diligently. I made a promise to God that if HE answers my prayer, I will build a chapel in the station.

There was a serious fight in the community, the miscreants hate one another, when they start their fight, the area will be an isolated zone.

It was only God that saved me, and enabled me to handle the sad situation. I keep records that, God if you relieve me out of this situation and use me to make the environs peaceful, I will build a chapel. And I came out and conquered, that I am going to make a temple for you, a temple which I have already

called, "THE COVENANT CHAPEL" under the Christian Police Fellowship of Nigeria, Lagos State Chapter.



Well, money is not a limitation to anybody who trusts in Christ, when people are shouting there is scarcity of money, people of God are shouting there is money, and that is the thing that is working for me. While others are crying that there is no money, God knows that I have not asked anybody to give me money but I will not fail to commend my Reverend, Ojojo Okezie, the District Superintendent of Apapa, Lagos, who is almost opposite the station. When I shared the vision to



him, he gave me maximum support, he gave all the wood I needed for the roofing, gave me blocks, and gave me Zinc, the long pan that is very scarce now. That was how I started before I started informing other people and they continued to respond positively. My supporters are not limited to Christians, Moslem friends also supported me. I have prayed here, and God delivered me so a combination of resources from both Muslims and Christians are contributing towards the building of the chapel. We did the foundation and the ceremony and then the church began to march forward to the extent it is now.

The building is almost completed, how do you feel?

I feel happy that God answered my prayers, I feel happy that people came to support me when I asked for assistance. At the stage it is now, I even feel it is slow because they are supposed to complete the ceiling from outside and then put in windows and tiles.

Though we have started using the place for worship now, we have had a three days programme, we do prayer and worship inside, and do every Thursday from 9.00 to 10am. Some churches have started coming to partner with us because it's one thing to build the temple and another to get people to worship in the chapel. So the members of this station have begun to know that every Thursday 9am to 10am is worship time. By the grace of God, it will be completed very soon.

What is your advice to state Coordinators?

Well, my advice to state coordinators is that they must know that to whom much is given, much is expected, you can't say you're a coordinator and you are waiting for manner to fall from heaven, speak out, the word of God said we should standout in every where we get to, we should open our mouth and God will answer, if you have a landed property and you have a place to build for God, don't say, I don't have money to build, talk to somebody and God will assist you.

But are not mindful of God command in Romans 13, to honor, respect and pray for those in authority. One may see the need for a Prison Ministry, but may question the need for evangelism in the Police.

Some may have concluded in their mind that Police Officers souls have been sold to the devil.

You may be interested to know that the first Gentile to be

converted to Christianity in the book of Acts 10 is a God fearing man named Cornelius.

He is an Officer of the law, an arm bearer, a security chief, and of course a Police Officer.

Are you aware the scripture speaks favorably of a Roman Centurion? The Lord was so amazed at his faith.

He is an army officer a Chief local law enforcement agent of his days. Apostle

Paul made it a point to share the good news of Jesus with the officers of his time, not minding the way he was being treated by them. Philippians 1:12 and 13, Act 16:20-34.

Too many people see Police Officers as brutal, corrupt and wicked, they see them as people who do not need God nor deserving of God's mercy. Let it be known that officers inhabit a world most people never know and can't comprehend.

They see things most people never see, most of which are bad, and some are horrific and very disgusting.

Most officers live, a life of physical and emotional stress, hurt, ambush and hatred. These burdens notwithstanding, they are expected to be super human; expected to carry out extraordinary, dangerous and difficult tasks without excuse or default.

Tell me if it is possible to carry out such a task without Jesus. If your answer is no, then get ready to pray for Police. You may not be convinced believing that Police officers are employed and paid to do those task. Yes it is, but be informed that the pay cannot compensate for the risk and damages suffered by offices and their families, simply for protecting your life and properties.

The Lord said that the greatest Love you can show is to give your life for your friend (John 15:3). Most officers will passionately give their life to protect the citizen.

By this, Police Officers are your friends even if you do not consider them to be one.

You may not care or see anything good about them. You

may not even see any reason why you should waste your precious time in praying for the Police.

If your reason is because of an encounter. You are solicited today to remember the command of our Lord. He demanded of you to make disciple of all nations. Mark 15:16. The Police is inclusive.

> As a believer, you are not allowed to hate. If your experience with the Police is your reason for not caring and invariably considering the Police as your worst enemy.

We advised Nigerians to keep faith in the word of the Lord that enjoined you to love your enemy and pray for those that persecute you.

Romans 12:4. Be reminded that God cares. Jesus died

for everybody includes the Police on the Cross. He wants Police Officers to walk the path of eternal life.

Be a partner with God, be a minister of Peace, intercede for peace and pray for the peace of the Officers, they are the peace Maker. Matthew 5:9: ' who eventually is the Police. Pray for your Police, because it's the plan of God to safe this nation. Your prayer count.

If you are not a believer and you are touched to pray for the Police, you need to repent for your sins for the Bible says that the Prayer of a sinner is an abomination unto the Lord Proverb 15:8.
