





I was crowned and certified by Oba Agwuaja in 2002 in Lagos State. To have authentic title one must be crowned by the Igwe, Eze, Oba or Ensi depending on the ethnic group, who are HRH or HRM certificate by the state government.

The Use of High Royal Highness/Majesty

The Unique Model: What advice do you have regarding the use of His Royal Highness/Majesty by some Eze Ndigbo?

High Chief Anselm Njoku: I strongly advise against Eze Ndigbo outside Igboland using His



Royal Highness/Majesty. Royalty means ownership of the land, and there can only be one royalty in a community. Eze Ndigbo should focus on preserving Igbo customs and tradition, not claiming royalty. The conditions to use His Royal Highness are clear: one must be an indigene of the land, crowned by the rightful authorities, and certified by the state government. "It is a tape of Igbo customs and traditions as well as that of the land where we live for an Igbo Eze outside Igbo land to be addressed as H.R.H or H.R.M; it is SACRILEGIOUS and must stop".

Ohanaaze and Igbo Speaking Community

The Unique Model: Can you elaborate on the role of Ohanaaze and Igbo Speaking Community?

High Chief Anselm Njoku: Ohanaaze is the apex social-cultural organization of Ndigbo, and all Igbo groups are under it. The primary role of Igbo Community is to ensure that Igbos living in a particular area stay together, have meetings, and ensure their welfare and protection.

Crowning Eze Ndigbo

The Unique Model: Who should crown Eze Ndigbo in Lagos State?

High Chief Anselm Njoku: Eze Ndigbo in Lagos should be crowned by Ohanaaze, following a thorough process involving Igbo Community leaders and other groups.
