A: From day one, I am a traditional man, right from the village. Even before they gave me the king of Igbo World Wide, I have collected about seven different titles from my village and our town Awka in Anambra. So, when people come to their palace, if they don't know culture/tradition, they will learn from their palace, especially their attire, speech, and total disposition of Igbo Culture and tradition.

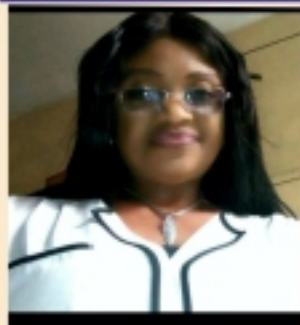

A: The strategy I will implement with the help of my team and the approval of our traditional rulers is encouraging our Igbo women to speak up and not keep shut to such violence, we would also organize quarterly seminars where we can invite specialists for talk shows as well.

Q: How will you collaborate with other organizations to advance the interests of Igbo women?

A: By engaging with the stakeholders like the commissioner for women affairs, etc. to collaborate with us in organizing regular skill acquisition programs where our women can learn and produce basic products which will generate income for them and their families in their respective communities.

Q: How do you plan to represent the interests of Igbo women worldwide, particularly in international forums?

A: By attending women's world conferences and seminars where critical issues concerning Igbo women are being discussed.

Q: What initiatives will you implement to empower Igbo women economically and socially?

A: Skill acquisition programs and the introduction of quarterly health and wellness programs.
